11% OF UKRAINIAN TERRITORY OCCUPIED BY RUSSIA

As of November 15, 2024, russia occupies about 66,900 km² of Ukraine's territory — 11% of the country within its 1991 borders.



REFUGEES AND DISPLACED PERSONS:

6.7 million Ukrainian refugees worldwide — approximately twice the population of Kyiv.



MEDICAL INFRASTRUCTURE DAMAGE:

At least **\$7 billion** in damages to Ukraine's healthcare system caused by russia.

1,877 medical institutions and **876 pharmacies** significantly damaged or destroyed.

Every 5th ambulance has been damaged.

Since russia's full-scale invasion, APH has supported over 1 million Ukrainians with life-saving aid. From HIV and TB care to launching mobile clinics in frontline areas, we've been addressing urgent health needs despite immense challenges.

These achievements are thanks to unwavering international support.

ALLIANCE FOR PUBLIC HEALTH CONTRIBUTIONS

- Over 1 million Ukrainians received support from APH.
- **HIV Response:** More than 40% of all individuals starting ART were referred and linked to care by APH and partners.
- **Tuberculosis:** 3747 vulnerable individuals were diagnosed with active TB and were linked to care and started treatment.
- Hepatitis C: Over 5,200 people living with HIV and tuberculosis received a comprehensive Hepatitis C services package, with 99.9% being people who use drugs (PUD) and their partners. A 98% treatment success rate was achieved. Evacuated clinics from Pokrovsk and Selidove continue providing HCV treatment to PUD at their new locations.
- Integrated Mobile Health Services in Rural Frontline Areas: Since December 2022, four mobile teams have operated in 293 remote frontline settlements across six regions: Kharkiv, Kherson, Mykolaiv, Donetsk, Dnipro, and Zaporizhzhia, completing 419 field visits. Serving over 18,000 patients, these mobile clinics provide primary care, TB and HIV screening, and bring medical staff and modern diagnostic equipment to remote locations where no clinics, doctors, or nurses are available.
- Humanitarian response: APH issued 913 mini-grants to support 544,691 people for housing, shelters, food, evacuation, relocation, reconstruction
- **Supporting internally displaced:** through 40,000 requests HelpNow ensured uninterrupted continuum of HIV, TB, drug addiction treatment and mental health support in 52 countries
- Innovations: Through successful advocacy efforts with PEPFAR, Ukraine introduced injectable cabotegravir (CAB-LA) for pre-exposure prophylaxis as part of a pilot project.
 - Deployed artificial intelligence to identify at-risk groups for testing and provide 24/7 online consultations via twiin.aph.org.ua.
- **Expanded Assistance:** Veterans with visual impairments, those who have undergone amputations and require prosthetics, as well as residents of de-occupied territories.
