DUTIES:

- Manage the research proposal development process, including staffing, budgeting, research and writing;
- Write and edit research papers including reports, policy briefs, and publications for peer-review journals;
- Develop new and maintain existing relationships with key stakeholders and researchers in Ukraine and worldwide;
- Provide research and data services to ensure that relevant Alliance activities are well informed and data driven;
- Represent the organization as a spokesperson and advocate at conferences, shareholders' meetings, policy meetings, and expert gatherings;
- Analysis of HIV epidemiological and study data for the national, oblast and rayon level to monitor trends and peculiarities in order to develop focused recommendations for IHV case finding and treatment programs;
- Create regional profiles of different populations affected by HIV and thus need to be linked to care.
- Support data collection and data analysis for key affected populations size estimation and HIV epidemic modeling
- Monitoring HIV cascade indicators among different populations using surveillance and programmatic data;
- Provide technical assistance to Public Health Center to conduct and analysis data of Integrated Bio-Behavioral Surveys;
- Support the data collection relate knowledge sharing within Alliance and counterparts;
- Monitor the international research agenda;
- Leading the Alliance Research Steering Committee activities;
- Establish the Alliance Internal Review Board (IRB) and supervise its activities;
- Undertake other duties as required.
