## Data analysis and monitoring specialist in human rights (consultant)

**About the project:** REAct is a system for monitoring and responding to human rights violations at the community level, implemented in 7 countries of Eastern Europe and Central Asia. Since 2019, there were recorded more than 6000 cases of human rights violations. REAct instrument is developed on DHIS2 platform and allows quantitative and qualitative analysis of collected data through diagrams, charts and excel tables. Read more [here](#) about project.

**About Organization:** The International Charitable Foundation "Alliance for Public Health" is a leading non-governmental professional organization which makes a significant impact on the epidemics of HIV/AIDS, tuberculosis, viral hepatitis and other socially dangerous diseases in Ukraine in cooperation with state partners and civil society organizations through providing financial and technical support to relevant programs, which cover over 300,000 members of most vulnerable populations, which is the highest indicator in Europe. **Aim:** Collected data is posted on the REAct website on the regular basis (annual and semiannual). In order to prepare annual publication of data there is a need of contracting a consultant.

**Period of contracting:** February – March 2022 with very probable extension and repetition of contacting

### Deliverables:

- Review registered cases of human rights violations on subject of correct fulfillment (perpetrator, type of violation, provided services)
- Create charts and diagrams based on given criteria
- Analyze and compare narrative description with indicated filters
- Ensure quantitative and qualitative analysis
- Horizontal and vertical review of massive data

### Requirements:

- Fluent in Russian and English
- Fundamental knowledge about human rights and HIV/AIDS sphere, discrimination of PLHIV and groups at risk
- Strong computer and excel usage skills
- Experience in data analysis and monitoring
- Prior experience in REAct will be an advantage
