1. Objectives:

A training should include basic information on evaluation, such as:

1. Role of the evaluation in the project cycle.
2. Creating SMART goals and objectives of the evaluation.
3. Use of logical models.
4. Evaluation statements.
5. Review of different evaluation tools.
6. Selecting a design for the evaluation of the intervention and implementation methodology.
7. Development of the evaluation protocol.
8. Communication of the evaluation results to different stakeholders.
9. The practical part of the training should include work on the protocol for the evaluation of one of the KP interventions, which participants will present at the end of the training to receive trainer’s feedback.

2. Key Deliverables

The consultant\organization is required to produce the following deliverables:

- Deliverable 1: Training agenda
- Deliverable 2: Training materials (presentations and practical exercises) according to the approved agenda
- Deliverable 3: Pre and post tests for the whole training module
- Deliverable 4: Participants’ outcomes obtained during the training session.
