Project goals:

- Institutionalizing effective HIV response models and processes in the EECA region to influence the improvement of the HIV care cascade in the region
- Removing barriers to services for key population groups to promote quality medical interventions based on human rights principles; overcoming gender barriers to services
- Budget advocacy for sustainable services for key populations in the EECA region

Georgia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Moldova, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Serbia, Tajikistan, Ukraine, Uzbekistan.

Development of a number of innovative IT solutions for use at the national and/or regional levels to strengthen the effectiveness of programs to combat the HIV epidemic is a separate significant block of the project.

Purpose and subject of the call: selection of IT specialists to include in the pool of Alliance consultants who will work in accordance with the framework requirements (terms of reference, technical specifications) or other relevant tasks from the leadership of the Alliance across projects, in particular - the SoS_project 2.0 project. It is planned that, based on the results of the competition, a number of IT specialists will be selected for the development of new local or web systems \ IT applications (including applications for mobile devices), the

development of which is planned as part of the project, and/or the improvement of existing IT systems used and accompanied by Alliance resources.

Period of performance of works/provision of services: January - December 2024

The main areas of performance of work/providing services:

- 1. Development of chat bots and mobile applications for the purpose of collecting information, automating processes, assisting in work in prevention projects, detection, etc.
- 2. Development of processes for automatic remote crediting of monetary rewards to Alliance program participants. Development of loyalty programs.
- 3. Development of prediction models based on machine learning. In-depth statistical analysis of data in real time, etc.
- 4. Website maintenance and development, namely: making necessary changes, adding new tests, developing new illustrations, developing tools, etc.
- 5. Participation in working meetings and interaction with national and international partners regarding the development, implementation, development, support and modernization of IT systems used or supported by the Alliance.
- 6. Development, or partial participation in the development, of project technical documentation (specifications) for the development, implementation, development, support and modernization of IT systems used or supported by the Alliance.
- 7. Analysis, design and development of IT architecture of both new and existing IT systems to be used or supported by the Alliance.

- 11. Carrying out other tasks of the Alliance's project management related to the IT competence of development and testing (QA) of the software that is used, or should be used, as an IT toolkit for automating and supporting the processes of the Alliance and its Partners.
