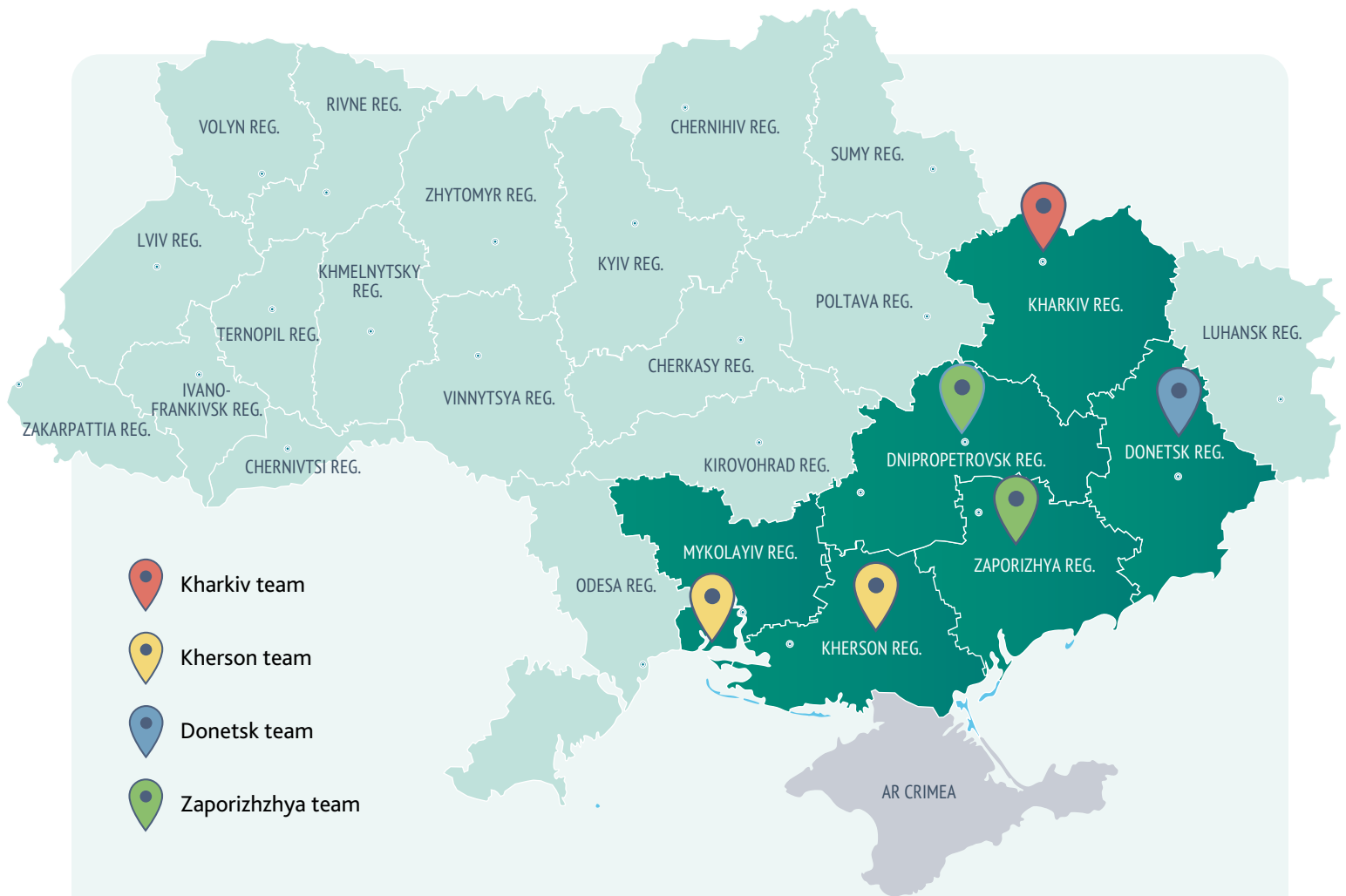


This project is dedicated to supporting individuals most affected by the war in Ukraine, particularly those residing in rural, hard-to-reach frontline communities within 7 to 30 kilometers of conflict areas with limited access to medical services. All visits are well-coordinated with local health and military administration and community heads.

Alliance offers integrated mobile clinic services in rural and frontline areas for several key reasons. We provide a specialized fleet of large vans, uniquely designed and fully equipped to deliver comprehensive health services. Each van contains two separate rooms and an independent electricity supply, ensuring reliable lighting, diagnostic equipment operation, and climate control. These features are crucial for delivering healthcare in rural communities near the frontline, where issues with heating, electricity, and suitable facilities are common.

Each team works for three-four days in one trip. During one working day each team covers one or more rural communities, depending on the number of people who need medical attention. It takes at least three days to carefully prepare each field trip, assess safety situation and needs, contact with local communities, government and health authorities, plan logistics and routes, prepare equipment, medication, supplies.

SERVICES IN MOBILE CLINICS



1. Primary health

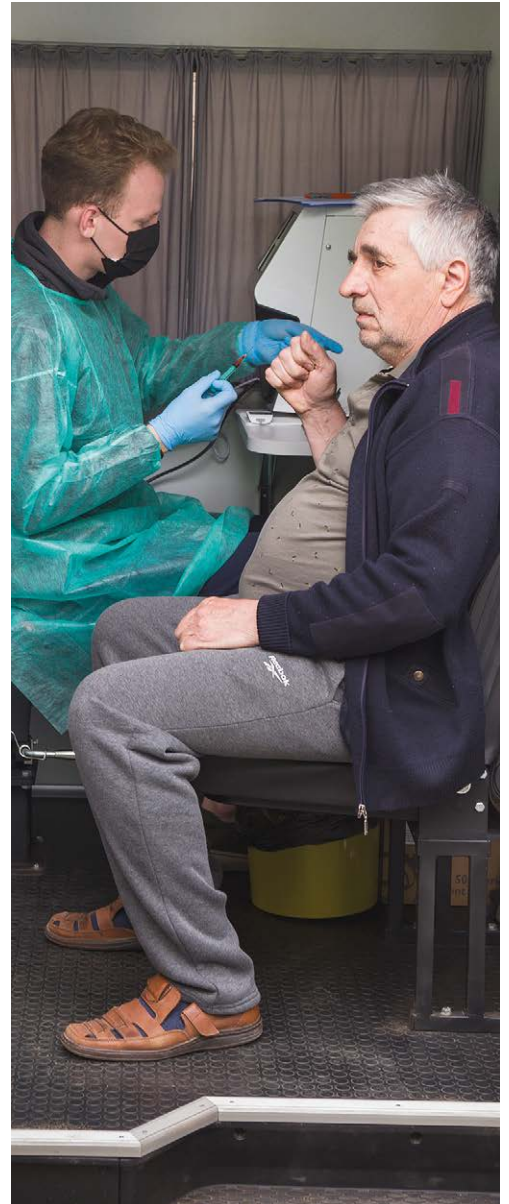
The first clinic is used by two primary health doctors. They provide counselling on general medical issues, including chronic and infectious diseases; prescribing treatment and issuing the necessary drugs for a period of 30 days, referral to other health specialists if necessary.

2. Mobile laboratory and diagnostic

Second clinic has room equipped with an examination couch for basic diagnostics using cardiograph, glucometer, tonometer as well as portable ultrasound (only one out of four teams have ultrasound equipment as for now). All diagnostic procedures are assigned by a doctor, and patient comes back to a doctor with results to continue consultation. Another room of this van is used for portable lab diagnostics using hematology analyzer and rapid tests for HCV, HIV, syphilis, COVID, troponin, etc.

3. Specialized TB screening and diagnostics

In partnership with local TB health facilities third clinic is used for TB screening and diagnostics with GeneXpert and ultra-portable X-ray. This involves local social and health workers to identify those who experience symptoms or might be at risk of TB. HIV, HCV and TB screening and diagnostics is supported by The Global Fund and Expertise France.

Kharkiv team

Launched specialized TB screening and diagnostics in April 2024, utilizing ultra-portable X-ray and GeneXpert technologies.

SOCIAL NETWORK STORIES



That day, we worked in collaboration with military and were ready for immediate evacuation when we noticed an enemy reconnaissance drone. So we had to work quickly and without the slightest pause to be able to consult and provide assistance to as many people as possible. Local residents, although adapted to danger, are under severe stress. [...] Despite the fact that each trip to Donetsk poses a risk to our team, we cannot refrain from going.

With each new trip of our mobile clinics, we become more convinced of their necessity. The people we meet in villages, which are wounded but not defeated by war, inspire us to believe in better times despite everything. It is an honor for us to work for those from whom war has taken away light, heating, water, the ability to receive medical treatment, but it will never take away faith, courage, and strength, and it will never extinguish the inner light.

Due to the proximity to the front lines, not many humanitarian missions dare to come to villages like Dudchany in Kherson region. The threat of shelling here is constant. But each of our trips here is a warm welcome. Local residents remember our doctors by name; if someone doesn't come, they worry, ask if everything is okay, prepare coffee for us, and eagerly request us to come again.

In another village in the Kharkiv region, we are greeted with a pleasant surprise - a patient who is a hundred years old comes for a check-up to our clinic! She says that four generations live in her house, and she promises that on our next visit, the whole family of long-livers will come for a consultation with the doctor.
