Consultant for Coordination of Innovative Approaches to Mental Health

Background

The Alliance for Public Health is seeking a consultant to provide comprehensive coordination of activities in the area of innovative approaches to mental health and differentiated service delivery. The consultant will ensure end-to-end coordination of the Cognitive Behavioural Therapy (CBT) and ketamine-assisted therapy components, including planning, engagement with partners and specialists, organisation of training and supervision activities, monitoring of implementation, and documentation of results.

This work continues the adaptation, implementation, and documentation of new psychotherapeutic and clinical models of care for people who use stimulants and other key populations in Ukraine.

Scope of Work

The consultant will be responsible for the overall programmatic, technical, and operational coordination of the relevant components and will work closely with the project team, implementing partners, psychologists, psychiatrists, trainers, supervisors, and service sites.

Key tasks of the consultant:

- Comprehensive coordination of the implementation of the CBT and ketamine-assisted therapy components in accordance with the agreed workplan;
- Development, maintenance, and regular updating of the implementation plan for the relevant areas, monitoring of task completion and deadlines;
- Coordination of interaction between the project team, implementing partners, psychologists, psychiatrists, trainers, supervisors, and other engaged specialists;
- Coordination of the implementation and documentation of CBT-based and psychotherapeutic services for people who use stimulants;
- Organisation and coordination of regular supervision sessions for psychologists involved in delivering CBT services, including scheduling, communication with supervisors, and tracking participation;
- Coordination of the preparation and delivery of the ketamine-assisted therapy training(s), including engagement of trainers, development of the programme, organisational support, and documentation of results;
- Coordination of further implementation of the ketamine-assisted therapy component and interaction with clinical specialists and service sites;
- Support for the development, review, and improvement of protocols, workflows, record-keeping forms, and other operational tools for the relevant areas;
- Monitoring progress, identifying risks, delays, and operational barriers, and preparing proposals to address them;
- Ensuring consistency between the clinical, psychosocial, training, research, and programmatic components of the work;
- Coordination of the collection, consolidation, and documentation of data, specialists' experience, and implementation results for the relevant components;
- Preparation of regular updates, trackers, reporting materials, presentations, and

- contributions to programme reporting;
- Contributing to the preparation of practical, training, and advocacy materials based on the experience of implementing the components;
- Ensuring the activities comply with agreed programmatic, ethical, and safety standards.

Expected Deliverables

- The CBT and ketamine-assisted therapy components are coordinated in accordance with the agreed workplan;
- Regular coordination with partners, clinical specialists, psychologists, trainers, and supervisors is ensured;
- The ketamine-assisted therapy training(s) are organised and coordinated;
- Regular coordination of supervision for psychologists working in the CBT component is ensured;
- An up-to-date tracker of the implementation of the relevant components is maintained, with progress and risks regularly monitored;
- Necessary protocols, workflows, record-keeping forms, and operational tools are maintained and updated as needed;
- Results, implementation experience, and key lessons are systematically documented;
- Regular updates and contributions to programme and final reporting are prepared.

Requirements

- University degree in public health, psychology, mental health, social sciences, or a related field, or equivalent professional experience;
- At least 5 years of relevant professional experience in mental health, harm reduction, public health, or related programmes;
- Experience coordinating projects, programmes, or complex components involving multiple partners and specialists;
- Understanding of psychotherapeutic approaches and the organisation of mental health services; experience with CBT is an advantage;
- Experience coordinating training, mentoring, and/or supervision for specialists;
- Experience engaging with clinical specialists, NGOs, service providers, or public health programmes;
- Ability to plan and coordinate several parallel workstreams, monitor task completion and deadlines;
- Strong organisational, communication, and writing skills;
- Strong analytical skills and experience preparing reports and programme documentation;
- Fluency in Ukrainian and good working knowledge of English.

Terms of Assignment

- Assignment period: July–December 2026;
- Work format: mainly remote, with possible travel within Ukraine depending on project needs and the security situation;
- Contract format: consultancy services / lump sum;
- The consultant will work in coordination with the Alliance for Public Health project manager.
